Notice of Review of Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations

Notice is hereby given that the City of York Council in exercise of its powers under The Review of Polling District and Polling Places (Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2006 is to conduct a review of polling districts, polling places and polling stations within the city council area. Following the review the council may decide to alter the boundaries of polling districts and the allocation of polling places and location of polling stations within polling districts.

City of York Council is seeking to ensure that all electors have such reasonable facilities for voting as are practicable including those electors who are disabled.
