OCCASIONAL STREET TRADING CONSENTS

A Street Trading Consent is required to sell any item in the street or on land to which the public have access without payment.

The occasional Street Trading Consent fees for the period 1 April 2008 to 31 March 2009 are as follows:

Food	-	£50.00 per day
Non Food	-	£37.00 per day
Charity	-	£14.00 per day

(Cheques should be made payable to the City of York Council)

If you wish to trade on behalf of a charity on the charity stall area in the city centre, you will need to seek permission from the City Centre Manager's Office and should contact the city centre office on York (01904) 552273 in the first instance.

Please submit the application form giving seven days notice wherever possible. An application should normally be determined within five working days.
