POSTER COMPETITION ENTRY DETAILS

The competition is open to individuals in the age range 6 – 11 and entries must be submitted into one of the following categories:-

1. Age Group 6 – 8 years
2. Age Group 9 – 11 years

Competition Rules:

1. This year's theme for our Poster Competition is "KEEP FOOD SAFE, DON'T SPREAD GERMS". We'd like you to design a poster using this theme to spread the word about good hygiene and food.
2. The design must be submitted on maximum A3 size paper and can use any media you choose e.g. pencil, paint, collage etc
3. Words may be used in the design but must not be the main part of it.
4. The entries must be from individual children.
5. Each entry must have the entrant's name, age and contact details on the back. Please remember this as we can't judge entries without this information
6. Entries will be judged on the following criteria:-
 - a clear understanding of good hygiene relating to food
 - overall quality of the design
 - imagination
7. Prizes will be awarded to the entries in each category that are considered by the Judges to best fulfil the above criteria. The decision of the panel of Judges is final.
8. Prizes will be awarded in September 2008. Prize winners will be notified of the arrangements. Any winners will be required to take part in local publicity.
