My main focus initially is working to make sure everyone who needs it has access to the latest information about the EU Settlement Scheme and ensure they feel part of the city which we're proud they call home."

Applications for the EU Settlement Scheme are now open and the process needs to be completed online. All EU citizens currently living in York are strongly encouraged to apply for pre-settlement or settlement status via the www.gov.uk website. The current deadline for applying is 30 June 2021 (31 December 2020, should the UK leave without a deal).

Citizens Advice York offer full guidance to applicants, including help filling out the form and advise on any issues which may arise during the application process. Book an 'assisted digital' help session with 'We Are Digital' when completing the EU Settlement Scheme online application. If you don't have the appropriate access, skills or confidence to complete the form you can contact us by telephone on:

EU citizens who do not wish to send their documents by post or are not able to use the government's 'EU Exit: ID Document Check' app, can make an appointment at York Register Office to have their ID documents scanned and verified, before applying to the EU Settlement Scheme.

Branching out



A team of volunteers from VINCI Construction UK have branched out to help us build new compost bays in Rowntree Park.

The new bays have been built as a solution to the build-up of leaves on the park's tennis courts.

The compost made by the leaf litter will then be used by the Friends of Rowntree Park to mulch and nourish the garden beds.

Having recruited new volunteers to clear leaves last autumn, these bays will support their work and maintain the quality of the tennis club courts which are surrounded by mature trees.
