**NOTICE OF MAKING**  
**THE MURTON (MURTON FOOTPATH NO 30/1/10)**  
**(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION)**  
**(CONTINUATION) ORDER 2019**

City of York Council (the Council), in exercise of powers under Section 14(1) and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport in pursuance of powers conferred upon him by Section 15(5) of the Act, hereby gives notice that, on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of March 2019 they made an Order continuing in force The Murton (Murton Footpath No 30/1/10) (Temporary Traffic Restriction) Order 2018 (original Order) that Order having an expiry date on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of March 2019. This is necessary to ensure that the bridge maintenance works being undertaken thereon can be undertaken safely. The effect of the Order is to continue in force the prohibition on pedestrians and vehicles from proceeding in the footpath known as Murton Footpath No. 30/1/10 (closed footpath) during the period commencing at 0001 hours on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of March 2019 and ending at 2400hrs on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of March 2020 (danger period) or at the end of the works period whichever is the earlier.

An alternative route for diverted pedestrians and vehicles will be available during the danger period.

Traffic signs/barriers will indicate the extent of the prohibition.

The Order does not prohibit works or emergency access nor does it prohibit access to premises provided such access is not prevented by on-going works.
