THE YORK (MICKLEGATE) (EXPERIMENTAL)
TRAFFIC ORDER 2018
NOTICE OF MAKING

Notice is hereby given that on the 29th day of November 2018 City of York Council (“the Council”) in exercise of powers under Section 9, 10 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of police in accordance with Schedule 9 of the Act, made The York (Micklegate) (Experimental) Traffic Order 2018 (“the Order”) which comes into effect on 10th December 2018 for an experimental period of 18 months ending on 9th June 2020 amends the York Traffic Management Order 2014 (or any replacement thereof) by:

Introducing a restriction on vehicles, with the exception of pedal cycles, travelling in a south westerly direction on Micklegate, York between a point 1 metre north east of the north eastern boundary line of Micklegate Bar and the south eastern boundary line of Micklegate Bar.

The council will be considering, in due course, whether the provisions of this Experimental Order should be continued in force indefinitely.

Any person wishing to object to the indefinite continuation of the Order must state their grounds for objection in writing to Assistant Director (Economy and Place), West Offices, Station Rise, York, YO1 6GA, so that the objection is received by no later than the 9th day of June 2019.

A copy of the Order, statement of reasons for making it and map showing the lengths of road affected may be inspected at the City of York Council Reception at West Offices, Station Rise, York, YO1 6GA during normal business hours. Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended or that a requirement of any regulations thereunder has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from the commencement date of the Order, make application for that purpose to the High Court.
