**NOTICE OF MAKING**  
**THE YORK (HUNGATE-PALMER LANE)**  
**(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION)**  
**(CONTINUATION) ORDER 2019**

City of York Council (the Council), in exercise of powers under Section 14(1) and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport in pursuance of powers conferred upon him by Section 15(5) of the Act, hereby gives notice that, on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of January 2019 they made an Order continuing The York (Hungate-Palmer Lane) (Temporary Traffic Restriction) Order 2017 (original Order) that Order having an expiry date on 17<sup>th</sup> January 2019. This is necessary because of the likelihood of danger arising from redevelopment works being undertaken thereon can continue to be carried out safely. The effect of the Order is to continue in force the prohibition on vehicles from proceeding and waiting in that length of (i) Hungate, York between its junction with Carmelite Street and a point 15 metres south east of its junction with The Stonebow and (ii) Palmer Lane, York (closed road) during the period commencing at 0001 hours on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of January 2019 and ending at 2400hrs on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 2020 or at the end of the works period whichever is the earlier.

An alternative route for diverted vehicles will be signed via The Stonebow, Garden Place, Carmelite Street and vice versa during the works period.

Traffic signs/barriers will indicate the extent of the prohibition.

The Order does not prohibit works or emergency access nor does it prohibit access to premises provided such access is not prevented by on-going works.
