**NOTICE OF MAKING**  
**THE YORK (LEEMAN ROAD & STATION AVENUE)**  
**(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION) ORDER 2019**

Notice is hereby given that on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of February 2019 City of York Council made an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is to prohibit pedestrians and vehicles from proceeding those lengths of footpath on the northern side (i) Leeman Road, York between its junctions with Station Avenue and the vehicle access road for The Esplanade car park; (ii) Station Avenue, York between its junction with Leeman Road and the Bar Walls (closed footpath) and prohibiting vehicles from proceeding and waiting in Leeman Road, York, between its junctions with Station Avenue and the vehicle access road for The Esplanade car park (closed road) during the period when flood defence works being undertaken thereon have been completed whichever is the earlier. That period commencing at 0001hrs on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of February 2019 and ending at 2400hrs on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of October 2019 (works period) or at a time when the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. This is to ensure that the said works can be carried out safely.

It is envisaged that the prohibition will only be put into effect in phases between the following times and dates (inclusive) at each location during the works period:

- (i) Leeman Road and Station Avenue, during the overnight period between 1900hrs and 0600hrs from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> February 2019 till Friday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2019;
- (ii) Station Avenue during the overnight period between 2000hrs and 0600hrs from Monday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019 till Friday 12<sup>th</sup> April 2019;
- (iii) Leeman Road, York from Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April 2019 till Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2019.

An alternative route for diverted traffic will be signed during the works period.

Traffic signs/barriers will indicate the extent of the prohibition.

The Order does not prohibit works or emergency access nor does it prohibit access to premises provided such access is not prevented by on-going danger.
