NOTICE OF MAKING
THE YORK (RAILWAY WALK)
(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION) ORDER 2014

Notice is hereby given that on the 6th day of November 2014 City of York Council made an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to prohibit pedestrians and vehicles from proceeding in the footway known as Railway Walk between its junctions with The Esplanade and Marygate Lane (closed road) during the period commencing at 0001hrs on 10th day of November 2014 and ending at 2400hrs on the 2nd day of April 2015 or on a date when nearby Scarborough Bridge reconstruction works being undertaken by crane operations from the closed footpath and adjacent car park have been completed whichever is the earlier. This is to ensure that the works can be carried out safely.

An alternative route for diverted pedestrians and vehicles will be available via Marygate Lane, Marygate, Dame Judy Dench Walk, Museum Street, Station Road, Station Rise, Leeman Road, the footpath linking Leeman Road and The Esplanade and vice versa.

Traffic signs/barriers will indicate the extent of the prohibition.

The Order does not prohibit works or emergency access nor does it prohibit access to premises provided such access is not prevented by on-going works.
