NOTICE OF MAKING
THE YORK (TANG HALL LANE AND ALCUIN AVENUE)
(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2015

Notice is hereby given that on the 8th day of January 2015 City of York Council made an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is to prohibit vehicles from proceeding and waiting in (i) Tang Hall Lane, York between its junction with Lang Avenue and Alcuin Avenue and (ii) Alcuin Avenue, York (closed road) during the period when footway and carriageway resurfacing works are being undertaken thereon that period commencing at 0001hrs on the 12th day of January 2015 and ending at 2400hrs on the 27th day of March 2015 or at a time when the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. This is to ensure that the said works can be carried out safely.

It is envisaged that the restrictions at each location will be put into effect at different times during works period.

An alternative route for the diverted traffic at each location will be signed.

Traffic signs/barriers will indicate the extent of the prohibition.

The Order does not prohibit works or emergency access nor does it prohibit access to premises provided such access is not prevented by on-going works.
