NOTICE OF MAKING
THE BISHOPTHORPE (SIM BALK LANE)
(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2015

Notice is hereby given that on the 22nd day of January 2015 City of York Council made an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is to prohibit vehicles from proceeding and waiting in Sim Balk Lane, Bishopthorpe between a point 50 metres north west and 50 metres south east of the A64(T) over bridge (closed road) during the period when bridge maintenance works are being undertaken thereon that period commencing at 1900hrs on the 26th day of January 2015 and ending at 0600hrs on the 25th day of April 2015 (works period) or at a time and date when the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. This is to ensure that the said works can be carried out safely.

It is envisaged that the closure will only be put into effect during ten overnight periods, between 8.00pm and 6.00am during the works period.

An alternative route for diverted traffic will be available via Sim Balk Lane, Tadcaster Road, Knavesmire Road, Campleshon Road, Bishopthorpe Road, Church Lane, Sim Balk Lane and vice versa.

Traffic signs/barriers will indicate the extent of the prohibition.

The Order does not prohibit works or emergency access nor does it prohibit access to premises provided such access is not prevented by on-going works.
