Introduction

City of York Council is adopting a personalised approach to meeting adult's transport requirements, enabling more people to exercise independence, choice and control over their transportation needs via **Transport Direct Payments**.

Adult customers who have been offered a **Transport Direct Payment** will be able to choose their support from a List of CYC Approved Providers within this document. (Customers are able to pursue other creative transport options or to purchase support from providers not included on the list if they wish to do so).

Please note that there is no direct contractual relationship between the Council and the providers on this Approved List. However, providers who have been included on this list have evidenced standards of good practice to the Council in terms of vehicle and driver safety and customer awareness.

The Council will investigate complaints where a Provider does not appear to meet these standards and may remove the Provider from the Approved List where these complaints are upheld.
