## **Murton Neighbourhood Plan Referendum**


## **Information Statement**

A Referendum relating to the adoption of the Murton Neighbourhood Plan will be held on Thursday 10 July 2025. Notice of Referendum attached.

The question which will be asked in the Referendum is:

"Do you want City of York Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Murton to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?"

The Referendum area is identified on the map which is included below, with this Information Statement.



The Referendum area is identical to the area which has been designated as the Murton Neighbourhood area.

A person is entitled to vote in the Referendum if on Tuesday 24 June 2025

- he or she is entitled to vote in a local government election in the Referendum area;
   and
- his or her qualifying address for the election is in the Referendum area. A person's
  qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the register of electors, the
  address in respect of which he or she is entitled to be registered.

The Referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the Referendum is  $£2,362 + (0.059p \times number of entries on the relevant register)$  The number of persons entitled to vote in the Referendum by reference to which that limit has been calculated is 506.

The Referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures which are similar to those used at local government elections.
