We are making a new plan about sport and activities in Fulford.

The survey covers the following areas of Fulford.



Fulford Parish Field, this is also known as School Lane Playing Field (outlined in red). It is looked after by Fulford Parish Council.



Persimmons Field (outlined in blue) this is a green space in the new building site at Germany Beck.



Fulford Parish Hall, this is also known as Fulford Social Hall (outlined in orange)



Fulford Parish Field Sports Pavilion (outlined in yellow)

About the survey

The questionnaire asks you about **Facilities**. Facilities are buildings, equipment or services available for people to use.



Examples of facilities are:

- Play equipment for children



- Toilets, changing rooms and hand washing



- Bins for rubbish and dog waste



- Café or takeaway stand

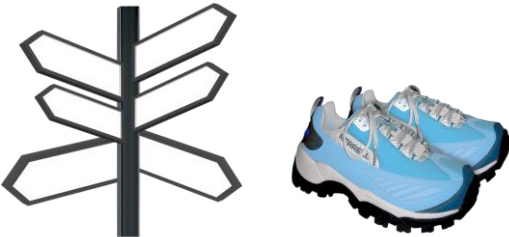




- Lawns and gardens



- Wildlife and nature



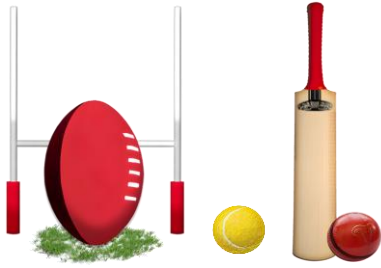
- Paths for walking and running



- Open spaces for activities and picnics



- Benches and seating areas



- Equipment or areas for sports, for example football pitches, tennis courts or basketball hoops.



At the end of the questionnaire there are questions **About you**.

These include:



- how old you are



- your gender



- your race, culture and background



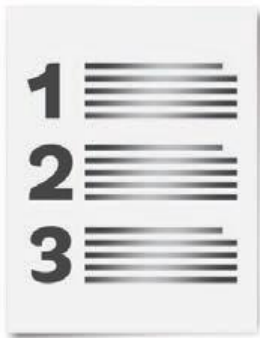
- whether you see yourself as disabled.



You do not have to answer these questions if you do not want to.



You need to give us your answers by **25th October 2025**.



How to give us your answers

There are lots of different ways you can give us your answers:

- You can hand in your form at our main offices. Our main offices are called West Offices in York.

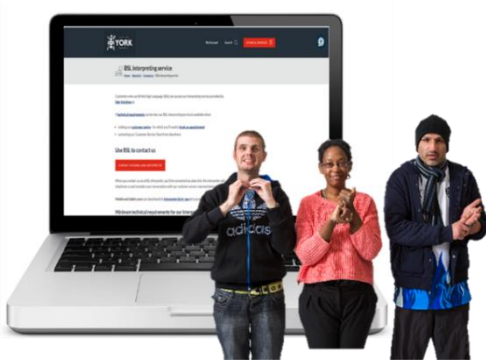

The information is not in easy read. You might want to ask someone to help you read it.



Our privacy notice

Before you answer our questions, you need to read our **privacy notice**.



It tells you how we will use and look after the information you tell us on the form.



The law says organisations must have a privacy notice.



It is up to you if you want to take part in the survey.

You do not have to take part if you do not want to.



If you take part, you do not have to answer all of the questions.



How we will use your information

We can only use the things you tell us if you agree. This is called **giving consent**.



We will use what people tell us to write a report.



If we write what you tell us in the report, we will not put things like your name or address in it.



That way nobody can tell it was you who told us.



How we look after your information

We will keep your information locked up safely on our computers.

We will only share your information with other organisations:



- If the law says we need to share it

or



- To stop someone from getting hurt.



We will only keep your information for as long as we need it. Then we will delete it.



Your rights

Your **rights** are things you are allowed to do and how you should be treated.



The law says you have rights when we keep information about you.

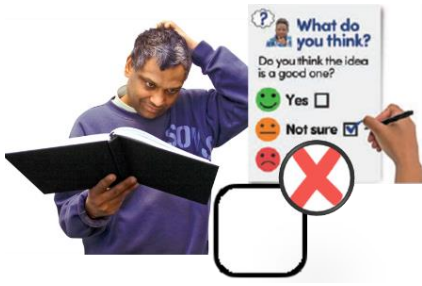
