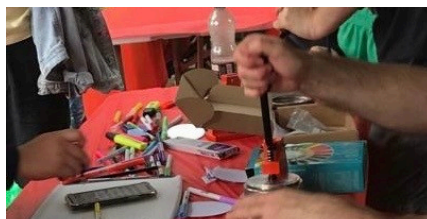

Trail Map Guide

1

West Offices

Originally the headquarters of the North Eastern Railway (NER), now housing City of York Council. Open 10am-4pm on 5 July for Armed Forces Day.

2

North Eastern Railway War Memorial

Memorial outside York Railway Station honouring over 2,200 railway employees who died in WWI and WWII, designed by Sir Edwin Lutyens.

3

Railway Station – Baedeker Raid Plaque

Commemorates victims of the April 1942 air raid that targeted York's strategic railway connections.

4


Leeman Road Memorial Gardens

These gardens commemorate local residents and railway workers from the area who died in both World Wars and later conflicts.

5

Multangular Tower

This Roman military structure was used for defence and housed a catapult. It was reinforced in Medieval times and saw action during the English Civil War.

St Mary's Tower

Medieval defensive tower near Museum Gardens, damaged by Parliamentary cannon fire during the 1644 siege of York.

7

York Minster

Suffered blast damage during the 1942 Baedeker Raids; housed memorials and services for war-affected soldiers and civilians.

8

Emperor Constantine Statue

Marks where Constantine was proclaimed Roman Emperor in 306 AD, highlighting York's role as a Roman military centre.

9

Minerva Bust (Petergate)

Modern sculpture of the Roman goddess of war, reflecting York's history as the fortress of Eboracum.

10

Garden of Remembrance

Honours Yorkshire soldiers lost in both World Wars and later conflicts, with tributes to local regiments.

Bettys (Café)

A WWII meeting place for RAF personnel, with the 'Bettys Mirror' in the basement still displaying etched signatures of airmen.

Mansion House

Official residence of the Lord Mayor of York and central to the city's defence coordination during both World Wars.



13

Parish of All Saints' Pavement Church

Regimental church of the Royal Dragoon Guards, containing memorials to soldiers and serving as a place of commemoration.



14

Fishergate Bar

Medieval gateway damaged during the 1461 Siege of York in the Wars of the Roses, controlling southern access to the city.



15

St George's Field

Former Medieval military mustering ground and barracks site, later used during the English Civil War





16

Castle Museum

Located in a former military prison, featuring exhibitions on wartime history, including '1914: When the World Changed Forever'.

17

Clifford's Tower

Surviving keep of York Castle, a Norman stronghold pivotal in medieval wars and the English Civil War.

18

York Army Museum

Home to the collections of the Prince of Wales's Own Regiment of Yorkshire and the Royal Dragoon Guards.

19

Baile Hill

Norman motte-and-baile castle (1068), part of York's dual-castle defence system with Clifford's Tower, used for military surveillance.

20

West Offices

The trail starts and ends here. Thank you for taking part.







Not on the map but worth a look:

Lt Col Bertram Best-Dunkley Commemorative Paving Stone, Mount Vale

Honours the officer awarded the Victoria Cross following the Battle of Passchendaele (1917).

Spurriergate Centre, St Michael's Church, Coney Street

A Medieval church now a centre which hosts the Armed Forces Drop-in sessions on Tuesdays, 10:30am–12:30pm.

Pilot Officer Yves Mahé Plaque, Coney Street

Honours the French pilot who defended York during the 1942 Baedeker Raids against the Luftwaffe, so saving the munitions-filled Rowntree factory.

St Martin le Grand Church, Coney Street

Dating to the 11th century, this city centre church was heavily damaged in the 1942 Baedeker Raids and was restored (1961-68) by architect George Pace.

St Lawrence's Church, Lawrence Street

Displays memorial tablets for York's fallen in World War I and II.
