### MURTON PARISH: CENSUS DATA

#### NOTES

1. Area 1 is Murton Village (Blue Coat, Smary Lane, Moor Lane, Murton Garth, Murton Way); Area 2 covers the southern periphery of the Parish which includes Meam Close, Redbarn Drive, Moins Court, Cavendish Grove and parts of Tranby Avenue and the Hull Road.
2. Housing occupancy lists the total number of residents normally resident in the household
3. Social grade: AB, higher and intermediate managerial, administrative or professional grades; C1, Supervisory, clerical and junior managerial/administrative/professional positions; C2, Skilled manual workers; DE, Semiskilled and unskilled workers; those on state benefit/unemployed and lowest grade workers
4. Employment. Based on residents aged 16-74 on Census Day, 2021

**Level 4** qualifications or above: degree (BA, BSc), higher degree (MA, PhD, PGCE), NVQ level 4 to 5, HNC, HND, RSA Higher Diploma, BTEC Higher level, professional qualifications (for example, teaching, nursing, accountancy)

**Other qualifications:** vocational or work-related qualifications, other qualifications achieved in England or Wales, qualifications achieved outside England or Wales (equivalent not stated or unknown)

The dimensions of deprivation used to classify households are indicators based on four selected household characteristics.

**Education:** A household is classified as deprived in the education dimension if no one has at least level 2 education and no one aged 16 to 18 years is a full-time student.

**Employment:** A household is classified as deprived in the employment dimension if any member, not a full-time student, is either unemployed or economically inactive due to long-term sickness or disability.

**Health:** A household is classified as deprived in the health dimension if any person in the household has general health that is bad or very bad or is identified as disabled. People who have assessed their day-to-day activities as limited by long-term physical or mental health conditions or illnesses are considered disabled. This definition of a disabled person meets the harmonised standard for measuring disability and is in line with the Equality Act (2010).

**Housing:** A household is classified as deprived in the housing dimension if the household's accommodation is either overcrowded, in a shared dwelling, or has no central heating.
