The hearing sessions will start on **Tuesday 10 December 2019 at 10.00am**. They will be held in the Gimcrack Rooms at **York Racecourse**, Knavesmire Road, York YO23 1EX.

How to get to the Racecourse

The Racecourse is easily accessible by car from all major transport routes. From the A64 follow the A1036 (Tadcaster Road) north towards York City Centre and then along Knavesmire Road. For those wishing to use satellite navigation, the postcode is YO23 1EX.

There is ample free parking on Racecourse Road, including disabled parking.

The designated disabled car parks are on Knavesmire Road adjacent to the County Stand Enclosure and off Bishopthorpe Road, adjacent to the old factory. They are free to blue disabled badge holders.

The Council has also provided information about travelling to the York Racecourse from the railway station which is about 1.4 miles away:

Taxis are available directly outside the station.

<u>Walking</u> (approximately 30 minutes walking time): As you leave York Railway Station entrance foyer, turn right onto Queen Street and walk over the bridge to the traffic lights at Micklegate Bar (by the Windmill Pub on the corner). Turn right on to Blossom Street, at the traffic lights. Continue along Blossom Street, through 3 sets of traffic lights. After the third set of traffic lights, the road starts to go downhill towards the Racecourse. Take the second road on the left (Knavesmire Road – a long tree lined road next to the Racecourse). As the road bends round to the left, take the road on the right - Racecourse Road (with a high wall along the right hand side, behind the Racecourse Grandstand) until you come to the footbridge over the road. The entrance to the venue is on the right just before the footbridge. Follow the signs to the Gimcrack Rooms where the Examination is being held.

<u>Bus:</u> York does not have a central bus station, but York Railway Station is the nearest bus hub to the Racecourse.

There are a number of bus routes which run to/from the Racecourse, from various parts of the City including service numbers 11, 21, 26 & 197.
