This application form should be taken to City of York Council Licensing Section, Hazel Court EcoDepot, James Street, York, YO10 3DS, together the relevant fee, a basic Disclosure and Barring Service check for all persons listed in the application form and two forms of identification (i.e. driving licence, passport, utility bill etc).

Proof of identity checks may be undertaken by agencies as part of the application process.

Section 1 – Type of application

If you are applying for a new application please fill in all sections. If you are applying for anything else, please just fill in the sections where something has changed.

Section 2 – Applicant details

This section asks for details of your business. If you are an individual applying for the licence in your name, you should fill out the section 'Individual Applicants'. If your business is a partnership or other arrangement where there is more than one owner of the business, you should complete the 'Partnership or other unincorporated business' section. If your business is registered with Companies House and has directors or other person responsible for the management of the company, please complete the 'Incorporated company' section. A **director** or **partner** is someone who has or shares legal responsibility for the operation of the company, including filing returns at Companies House.

You do not have to complete every part of this section, just the part that relates to your business.

Section 3 – Site details

Fill out this section with the details of all the sites you operate as part of your business.

There is not much space on the form, so if you need to list more than two site managers, then please continue on a separate piece of paper setting out the details in the same way as the form. A **site manager** is the person who will be in charge of the site on a daily basis. You will probably need a different site manager for each site on the licence.

This section also asks you for the bank details which you will use to pay people for the scrap metal you receive or sell. This is to check that you are not selling the metal for cash, which is illegal. These details will be kept securely by the council.

Section 4 – Other licences

We ask for details of any other scrap metal licences you hold, or are applying for, including the name of the council that is granting them. Please make sure you include the licence number so that we can check this against the national register.

You may need to hold other environmental permits or licences that we should know about. For instance, if you carry waste as part of your business it is a legal requirement to register as a waste carrier. This includes transporting waste while travelling from job to job, to a storage place for disposal later, or to a waste disposal company or waste site. If your site(s) were established after 1990, then you are required to have planning permission from the council. You will need to tell us if this is the case, and it will be checked with the council planning department.

Section 5 – Motor salvage operator

This section asks if you will be salvaging motor vehicles as part of your work. The Scrap Metal Dealers Act 2013 brings together the Scrap Metal Dealers Act 1964 together with Part 1 of the Vehicle (Crimes) Act 2001, which means you now only need a scrap metal dealer's licence.

Section 6 – Payment details

There is a fee to apply for a licence. The fee varies from council to council as it reflects their costs of processing the form and checking that people are doing what the licence requires. Licences cannot be granted unless the correct fee has been paid. See details of fees at: https://www.york.gov.uk/MiscellaneousLicenceFees#SMD.

Section 7 – Relevant convictions

In this section every person listed on the application form needs to submit a 'Basic' check you can apply for this certificate by email at <u>customerservices@dbs.gsi.gov.uk</u> or telephone on 0300 020 0190.

This is because the Home Office has decided that you need to tell the council if you have been convicted of certain crimes. Possessing a conviction may not automatically prevent you from having a licence if the offence was unrelated to being a scrap metal dealer or a long time ago, and you can convince the council that you are a suitable person.

A 'Basic' check is considered to be only valid for a limited time, but can be used to apply to as many councils as you want within that time. Typically, three months is the longest that you can expect your check to be considered valid.

Section 8 – Declaration

You, and the other people named on the form, need to sign the form for it to be accepted. This section also explains that the council has to share some of your details with the police, Environment Agency, or Natural Resources Wales when checking you are a suitable person to hold a licence. Some of your information will also be displayed on a public register.

If you do not agree to this use of your information then you should **not** sign the form. If you are in any doubt about what this section means then speak to your council's licensing team.
