

Upper and Nether Poppleton Neighbourhood Plan


Referendum Information Statement

A referendum on the Upper and Nether Poppleton Neighbourhood Plan will be held on **Wednesday 23rd August 2017** from 7.00am to 10.00pm.

The question that will be asked in the referendum is:

Do you want the City of York Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Upper and Nether Poppleton to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?

The Referendum area is identified on the map below. The Referendum area covers the entire parishes of Upper Poppleton and Nether Poppleton and is the same as the area which has been designated as the Upper and Nether Poppleton Neighbourhood Plan area.



A person is entitled to vote if at the time of the Referendum, they meet the eligibility criteria to vote in a local election for the area and if they live in the Referendum area.

The eligibility criteria are:

- You are registered to vote in local government elections; and
- You are 18 years of age or over on Wednesday 23rd August 2017.

The Referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures which are similar to those used at local government elections.

The Referendum expenses limit that will apply to the Upper and Nether Poppleton Neighbourhood Plan is £4312.54. The number of people entitled to vote in the Referendum by reference to which this limit has been calculated is 3306.
