

<b>Appraisal</b>	<p>The ward is predominantly residential in character with the former British Sugar site to the north which is scheduled for redevelopment. The dense character of development means that greenspace provision is limited in quantity. However, the ward's proximity to the River Ouse corridor provides an important recreational resource.</p> <p>A potential regional biodiversity corridor has been identified running through the densely developed south of the ward from the Ouse to open countryside immediately to the west.</p> <p>The character of the ward is aligned with that of Westfield, Holgate Micklegate and Dringhouses &amp; Woodthorpe wards ('Urban West') and partly shares provision with these wards. Notwithstanding the in-principle deficits across all categories of greenspace, the proximity to significant sites in adjacent wards means that this is compensated for to a degree, although provision for children, young people and outdoor sports is a potential issue.</p> <p>Re-development of the British Sugar site and the Millfield Lane site will potentially increase the population of the ward by around 3,000 (a 35% increase), which will require provision to current standards as a starting point, as well as potentially compensatory provision for existing deficiencies (such as allotments). However, the case for the provision of formal parks and gardens is not strong given the proximity of natural/semi-natural and amenity greenspace.</p>



<b>Appraisal</b>	This is a predominantly rural ward, sharing characteristics with the adjacent Rural West and Wheldrake Wards. Provision is concentrated in Bishopthorpe to the north of the ward. There is mixed provision with a clear deficit in respect of general amenity and children's/teenage provision. Micklegate Stray/Knavesmire to the north provides an important amenity resource in reasonable proximity (although severed by the A64 ring road). A regional greenspace corridor has been identified to the east of the ward.
