Natural England is a non-departmental public body. Our statutory purpose is to ensure that the natural environment is conserved, enhanced, and managed for the benefit of present and future generations, thereby contributing to sustainable development.

Natural England notes the Defence Infrastructure Organisation Hearing Statement for Matter 5 Queen Elizabeth Barracks, Strensall (Sites ST35 And H59) dated July 2022. We do not consider that the statement presents any new evidence and can confirm that it does not change the position set out in our previous statements on this matter.

We note that para 1.5 g) states that the 2020 HRA takes no account of the 2021 Condition Assessment. Natural England is not concerned that the updated Strensall Common Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) condition assessment would materially affect the assessment or conclusions of the HRA however we advise it would be helpful to append the updated SSSI condition assessment and accompanying assessment notes with the final HRA for completeness.
