We wish to draw attention to the comment by the City of York Council on the section of the plan on "Roof Form" (Consultation Statement, p. 139), which notes that this section is "very prescriptive" and proposes a less prescriptive wording. It also suggests inclusion of a statement accepting contemporary design that deviates from this model if it can demonstrate exceptional design. The final plan as submitted does not include such a statement.

We regret that there is no acknowledgement that outstanding contemporary design can enhance the visual character of the village, and contribute to the "mix of building styles and sizes" that is recommended in the Design Guidelines (para. 8).
