

Please note that objections/representations cannot be treated as confidential and will come into the public domain. Copies of any objections or representations received will be disclosed to interested parties, including the Planning Inspectorate where the case is referred to it for determination.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council of the City of York, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State or part of it if the Authority has by Notice to the Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 may itself confirm the Order or that part of the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

This Order is made by the Council of the City of York under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to the authority order that the Former County Borough of York Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in:

Section 53(3)(c)(i). This is due to the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. The Council of the City of York hereby order that:

- 1. For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is 17 August 2023.
- 2. The Former County Borough of York Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
- 3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Public Bridleway York 138 and Public Bridleway York 308 Modification Order 2023
