


Dear resident

City of York Council is planning to bring back **Blue Badge parking** in the city centre.



Blue Badge parking helps disabled people park closer to where they need to go.



Blue Badge holders can already park in the city centre overnight between 5.00pm and 10.30am.



We are planning to have Blue Badge parking in the city centre during the day, between 10.30am and 5.00pm.



We want to know what you think of our plans.



Please answer the questions in this letter to tell us what you think by 4 February 2024.

Driving into the city centre



We need to change some of the roads to make it possible to drive into the city centre.



After we make these changes, Blue Badge holders will be able to park in the city centre between 10.30am and 5.00pm.

Goodramgate

You will be able to drive into the city centre on Goodramgate and leave on Colliergate.

From 4 January 2024



On Goodramgate you will need to show your Blue Badge to a support officer.




On Colliergate there will be CCTV cameras that see your car and let you leave.



You will also be able to drive down Church Street to park your car. But not St Sampsons Square.

After Easter 2024



You will be able to drive into the city centre on Blake Street and leave on Lendal.




On Blake Street you will need to show your Blue Badge to a support officer.



On Lendal there will be CCTV cameras that see your car and let you leave.


This is a map of these streets:




Question 2:

How can we make sure that Blue Badge holders can be picked up from the city centre?






