	<ol> <li>DC- shared a draft set of common standards for associations. Welcomed members feedback on whether these standards are fit for purpose</li> <li>MW- suggested that there should be a limit of at least 25% of vehicles in agreement for the group become an association and disallowing double membership</li> <li>DC- highlighted S3 on the document as a point to consider and asked for all feedback via e-mail</li> </ol>	
3.	Enforcement /Garage Testing Update	
	<ol> <li>DC- explained that there have been recent changes to staff in the enforcement. Currently in the process of changing how night enforcement works. Will also look at doing 'ad-hoc' student nights to cover mid-week events</li> <li>DC- looking at doing a plain clothed plying for hire operation</li> <li>DS- expressed the importance of enforcing the plying for hire operations. Explained that he has had unpleasant personal encounters that he has had when trying to prevent plying for hire</li> </ol>

	<ol> <li>WS- advised that the policy for new electric vehicles in is creating a barrier to entry. WS explained that hybrid/ electric vehicles are impractical for taxis due to the long times they spend driving, the lack of charging points and the time it would take to change them. Adding wheelchair accessible vehicles also does not improve the accessibility of wheelchair accessible vehicles</li> <li>DC- asked WS to put this into writing on an e-mail for further consideration</li> </ol>
