Becoming a Communication Friendly Setting What's involved?



- Staff member/s to complete Level 3 Speech and Language Support for 0-3's or 3-5's. This will be one staff member for early years settings with less than 10 staff and two staff members for settings with more than 10 staff. These staff members will;
 - Access 10 online sessions covering different areas of Speech, Language and Communication (SLC). This is self-directed learning, to be completed in practitioners' own time (1-1 ½ hours per week)
 - Participate in live weekly webinars with an Elklan Tutor These sessions will provide opportunities for discussion, questions and sharing ideas (1 hour per week)
 - Plan and implement strategies in their setting, and write-up their plan and reflections in an online e-log. This needs to be completed throughout the course and enables participants to gain accreditation (11/2-2 hours per week)

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2. Member/s of staff who have completed the Level 3 become the **Lead**Communication Practitioner(s) (LCP) for their setting. They will then go on to complete **Level 4**.

This staff member will;

- Be supported to train all the staff in the Early Years on the content from the level 3 course. This support is provided through 4 online seminars with an Elklan Tutor (*1-2 hour sessions*).
- Deliver five training sessions of the 'Communication Counts' training to ALL staff in their Early Years Setting (1 hour each).
- Complete an online Learning Log to achieve Level 4 accreditation

The organisation will;

• Gather evidence (via a learning log) to show how strategies have been embedded and the organisation is 'Communication Friendly'. This will be





- confirmed by an audit visit from a peer or an Elklan Tutor at the end of the programme (the final audit will take 1-1.5 hours)
- Have a *maximum of 2 years* to complete the 'Communication Friendly Setting' (CFSe) status award. Once an organisation has achieved CFSe, this accreditation is valid for *3 years*.
